It produces the warm look of an oiled floor, while establishing a hardwearing and stain resistant surface that is spot-repairable and easy to maintain. Bona Hard Wax Oil is highly suitable for floors with underfloor heating. It leaves an open, breathing surface that reduces the risk of side bonding.

APPLICATION

Bona Hard Wax Oil is suitable for indoor wood floor surfaces. For enhanced protection, apply 2 layers. For colour effects, prepare the surface with Bona Craft Oil and/or Bona Rich Tone, before sealing with 1-2 layers of Bona Hard Wax Oil.
