



# STRONGBOND MDF OVERLAY BOARD

### **TECHNICAL DATA SHEET**

**STRONGBOND MDF OVERLAY BOARD** is an underlayment predominantly used for wood sub-floor to provide a smooth and even finish for resilient floor coverings.

### **PRODUCT DISCRIPTION:**

- 5mm thickness with 1200mm in length and 1200mm in width
- Low formaldehyde E0 emission rating (less than 0.05mg/m3)
- Nominal Density is 800kg/m3
- Water Absorption Expansion 19%
- 5.8Kg in weight per sheet
- Natural Brown colour

## **PACKAGED**

160 sheets loosely stacked on a pallet.

#### **INSTALLATION:**

For best practice, we would recommend gluing the MDF sheets with a suitable Latex Acrylic or PVA based adhesive in a brick pattern. Full trowelled adhesive is required such as STRONGBONG 54P, STRONGBOND 888 or STRONGBOND DIY. The sheet shall be stapled with a 90 series 22mm staples, 50mm around the perimeter of the sheet and 100mm though the centre.

## **MATERIAL:**

It is made from Poplar and other miscellaneous products.



## **SUBSTRATE:**

The substrate must be dry, firm and free from dust. Please ensure the sub-floor ventilation is compliant with New Zealand building code.
