

Strongbond Plywood Underlayment

FEATURES

- 5.2mm thickness with 1220mm in length and 1220mm in width
- Low formaldehyde E0 emission rating (less than 0.05mg/m³)
- Nominal Density is 615kg/m³
- Moisture 6 to 12%
- 4.81Kg in weight per sheet
- Natural Brown colour

FSC CERTIFICATION

Our ply conforms with the requirements of FSC Chain of Custody Certification standard.

STRONGBOND RAMP EDGE is an underlayment predominantly used for wood sub-floor to provide a smooth and even finish for resilient floor coverings.

PACKAGED 90 sheets loosely stacked on a pallet.

INSTALLATION

For best practice, we would recommend gluing the plywood sheets with Latex Acrylic or PVA based adhesive in a brick pattern. Full trowelled adhesive is required such as STRONGBOND 54P, STRONGBOND 888 or STRONGBOND DIY. The sheet shall be stapled with a 90 series 22mm staples, 50mm around the perimeter of the sheet and 100mm through the centre.

MATERIAL

It is made from three layers of Poplar and finished with Birtongor face and back.

SUBSTRATE

The substrate must be dry, firm and free from dust. Please ensure the sub-floor ventilation is compliant with New Zealand building code.
